Reflection Questions

- What is the significance of James identifying himself as a "bond-servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ"? What does that mean for his life and ours?
- How does a trial reveal what's in your heart? What does that test show you about your desires and loves? As you recall your biggest trial, how have you responded to it? What has your response revealed about your faith in God?
- How have you been tempted in the past and how did you respond to that temptation? Based on your current temptations, what are some specific verses that you can use to fight those temptation?
- What does the phrase, "with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow" mean? Why is this so important when dealing with God's goodness? What are some practical ways to remember God's unchanging goodness during difficult trials in your life?

Ideas for Family Worship

Read James 1:1-18 and identify one or two things that it tells us about God and ourselves. Consider reading this week's catechism question as well (see below).
Sing He Will Hold Me Fast (page 4) together as a family.
Pray specifically thanking God for what he has revealed in his word and asking for the Holy Spirit to help your family live faithfully in light of it.


